



## Small Group Discussion Guide

June 10 & 11, 2017

### Introduction:

Intimacy and velocity are archenemies. If we do not make the deliberate choice to slow our lives down, we are in essence making the deliberate choice to hurt all of our relationships. The faster we go, the less time for depth we will have. We'll find that we are over-committed and under-connected. In Psalm 90:12, Moses wrote "Teach us to realize the brevity of life, so that we may grow in wisdom." As we look at how we can make the most of the time we're given, today's message will focus on how we can take the truth and wisdom of God's word and apply it to our relationship with Jesus and our relationship with our family.

### Discussion Questions:

1. We're going to start out by memorizing Psalm 90:12 together. Let's read it 5 times out loud together. We will then say it 5 times together from memory. Congrats! You've memorized a Bible verse today. Way to make the most of your time!
2. What are the most time consuming pieces of your life right now? Do you feel comfortable with how your time is being spent? If not, what would help you begin to invest your most valuable asset (your time) in the wisest places?
3. Is the speed of your life impacting the depth of your relationships (with God and others) right now?
4. Have you been using the "later box" recently? If so, how?
5. EACH of you discuss something you could do this summer to take steps closer to Jesus and spend time with Him.
6. EACH of you discuss something you could do this summer to invest in your family and make memories with them (or someone else's family or friend).
