Introduction: Jesus encourages his disciples to define the good life by finding God-life. Abundant and true life can be found in God's eternal kingdom rather than in the accumulation of possessions and earthly wealth. Jesus encourages his disciples to not be anxious because their Father delights in providing for his children and leading them to find ultimate joy and wealth in eternal things.

3. How does Jesus define life in his response to the man who wants a share of his brother's inheritance? (verse 15)
4. What are you tempted to covet? What false promises do these things try and convince you of?
5. Is your self-wealth hindering your God-wealth? If so, in what ways?
6. What tempts you to worry and grow anxious?
7. How do you define treasure in heaven and how are you seeking these things as a priority above all things?
